### Remarks from (39-42)

- 1. Each item is allotted 10 marks.
- 2. If the student uses a wrong question word, the answer rates **zero**.
- 3. If the student writes a question word only, the answer rates **zero**.
- 4. Deduct **2 marks** for each grammar mistake.
- 5. If the student writes two questions for the same answer, consider the first.
- 6. Overlook capitalization, punctuation and spelling mistakes.
- 7. Any logical question or answer related to the dialogue is accepted.

## **B- Rewriting**

### Remarks

- 1- Each corrected item is allotted 5 marks
- 2-If the student writes the corrections only, his answer rates full mark

- 2-Before starting the correction of the composition, the teacher should make first reading to the whole paragraph to figure out if it is relevant to the topic or not.

  b- A paragraph between 61-70 words rates (38 marks). Deduct one mark for every mistake as a package of (15 marks: 3 for pure and 12 for spelling and grammar).

  c- A paragraph between 51 60 words rates (36 marks). Deduct one mark for every mistake as a package of (13 marks: 3 for pure and 10 for spelling and grammar).

  d- A paragraph between 41-50 words rates (34 marks). Deduct one mark for every mistake as a package of (11 marks: 2 for pune and 9 for spelling and grammar).

  N.B. Overlook the first two grammar, two spelling and two punctuation mistate for items (a-b-c-d).

  c- A paragraph between 31-40 words (30 marks). Deduct one mark for every mistake as a package of (9 marks: 2 for punctuation and 7 for spelling and grammar)

  f- A paragraph between 21-30 words (25 marks)

  Deduct one mark for every mistake as a package of (5 marks: 2 for punctuation and 4 for spelling and grammar)

  g- A paragraph between (10-20) (20 marks)

  Deduct one mark for every mistake as a package of (5 marks: 1 for punctuation and 4 for spelling and grammar)

  N.B. Overlook the first grammar, the first spelling and the first punctuation ritems (c-f-g) h- A paragraph between (10-20) (20 marks)
