Samuel Beckett wrote novels, plays and poems in both French and English about human nature. In his works, he suggests that the purpose of life is not something that is given to us; it is something we must make for ourselves. This way of thinking is known as 'absurdism'.

Waiting for Godot is one of the most <u>famous</u> absurdist plays. The play is also somewhat symbolic. In the play, Beckett uses <u>satire</u> so that we can understand his views on human nature. Its two main characters – Vladimir and Estragon – are waiting for the mysterious Godot, who will <u>probably</u> never arrive. While they are waiting, they cannot find a purpose for their lives.

In this way, we see their foolishness and begin to understand how silly Beckett thinks it is to wait for a purpose, rather than making your own. His play is both tragic and comedic because he uses satire to make us laugh at his characters' silly behaviour at the same time as making us feel pity for them because of how they behave.
